# Elvis performance artist rocks for Camille's Memory Café

To borrow a phrase from one of Elvis Presley's biggest hits, A Gift of Time participants couldn't help falling in love with Elvis performance artist Mike Elliott when Georgetown Public Library hosted Camille's Memory Café Friday morning.

About 30 people attended the CMC event, which is one of the live and online offerings from A Gift of Time, a Georgetown non-profit serving those with mild to moderate dementia and their caregivers.

"When he was singing to the participants and you could see their reaction, that's what this is all about," Gift of Time board president Rick Vasquez of Georgetown said.

After a meet-and-greet time featuring other activities, Mr. Elliott sang for almost one hour. His repertoire included Presley's early rock-n-roll hits, as well as Gospel offerings and ballads.

Mr. Elliott lives in Round Rock and is co-owner of Texas Outdoor Power Equipment in Georgetown. He has a personal connection to the work A Gift of Time does.

"We lost my mom to Alzheimer's back in 2006, so it hits very close to home," Mr. Elliott said.

A Gift of Time board members said the performance was the first live Camille's Memory Café program since before the Covid pandemic started. Camille's Memory Café meets on the first and third Friday of each month. Going forward, A Gift of Time plans to keep its first-Friday programs online and go live with third-Friday events at the library.

Becky Foltz-May, A Gift of Time's executive director, thanked the library and its staff for the use of an upstairs meeting room. The library also donated coffee and a fruit tray.

The next live Camille's Memory Café is scheduled for October 21 from 10 a.m. to noon, when Simple Sparrow Care Farm in Hutto will bring rabbits and other animals to the library.

Pain and Other Assessments in a Person With Dementia Dementia professionals use a variety of tools to determine decline and remaining function in Persons With Dementia. Specific tools help us give physicians, nurses and caregiving staff a better picture of what is happening to the resident. Assessing for depression, anxiety, ADLs, IADLs, Pain, etc., keeps arguments out of the doctor's office and helps us to assist families in understanding the disease process. Pain causes an estimated 50 percent of the behaviors in a Person With Dementia. Learn how to assess, plan and provide for pain treatment, including the use of narcotic medications.

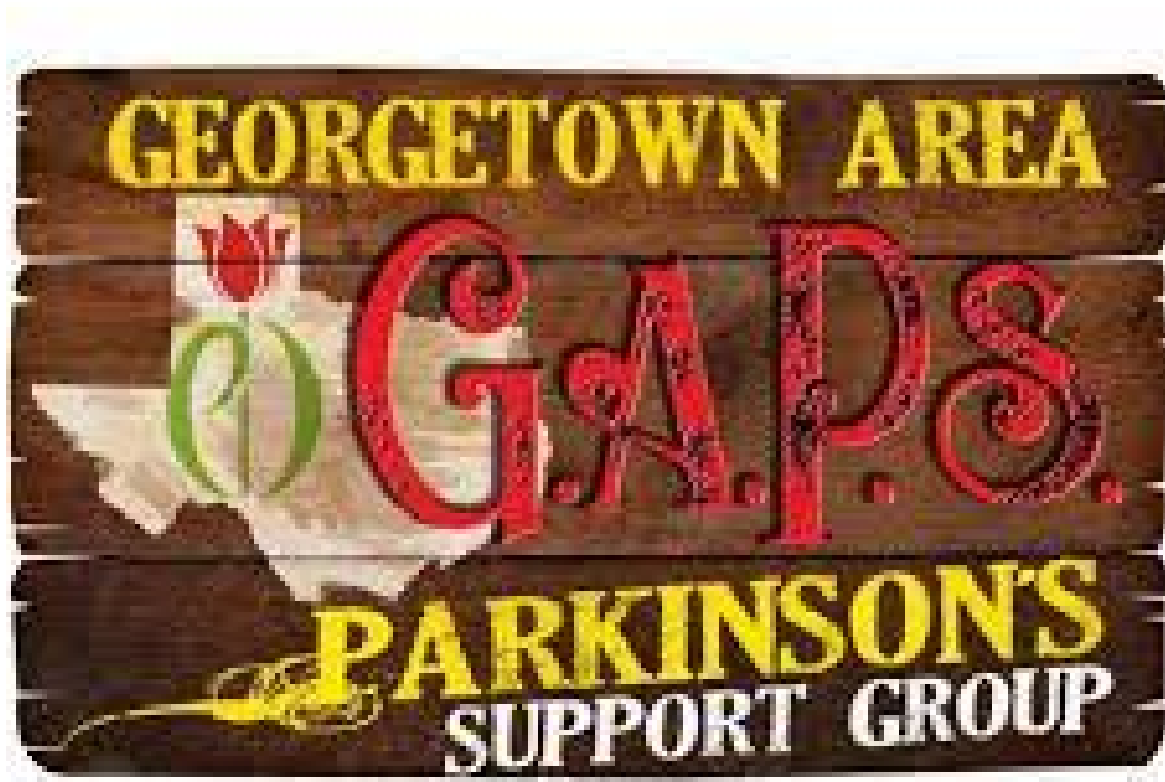
